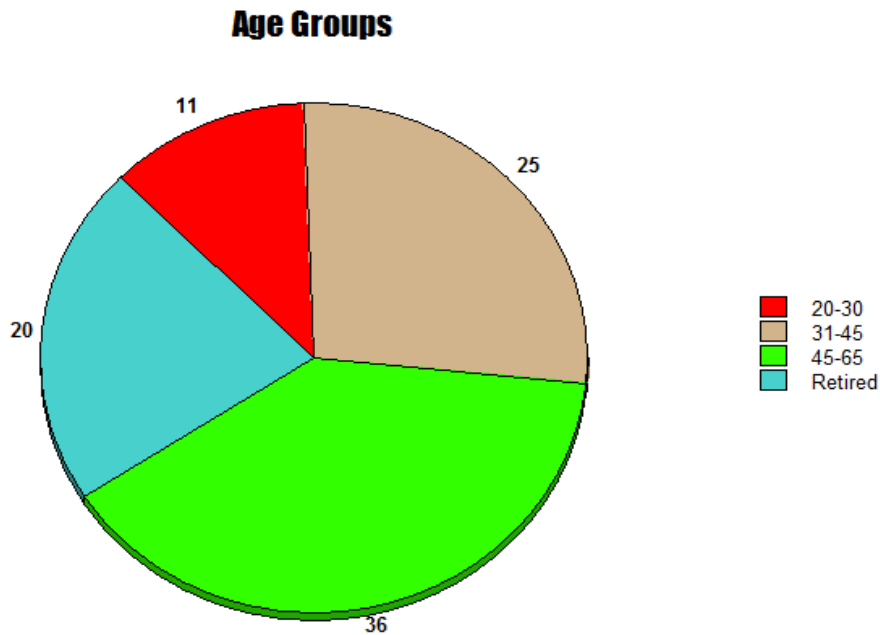
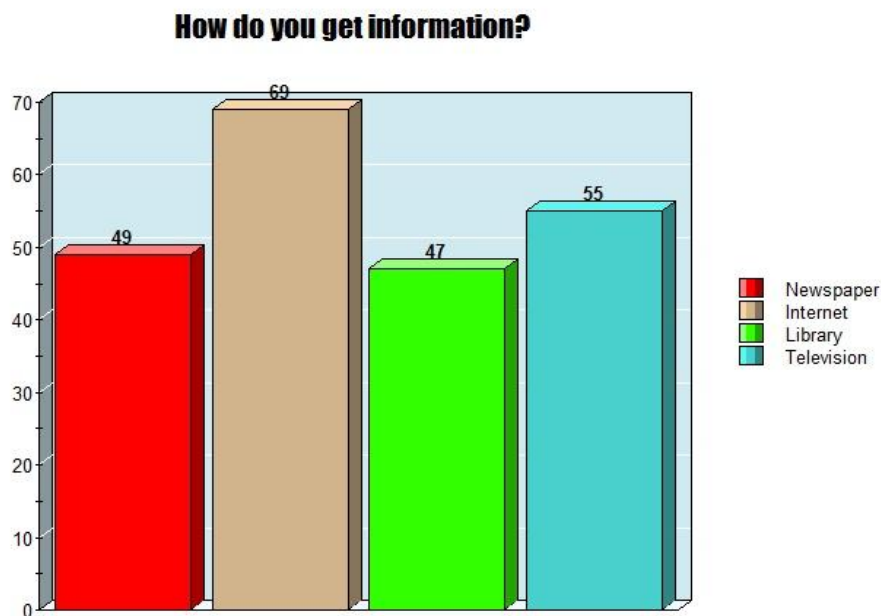

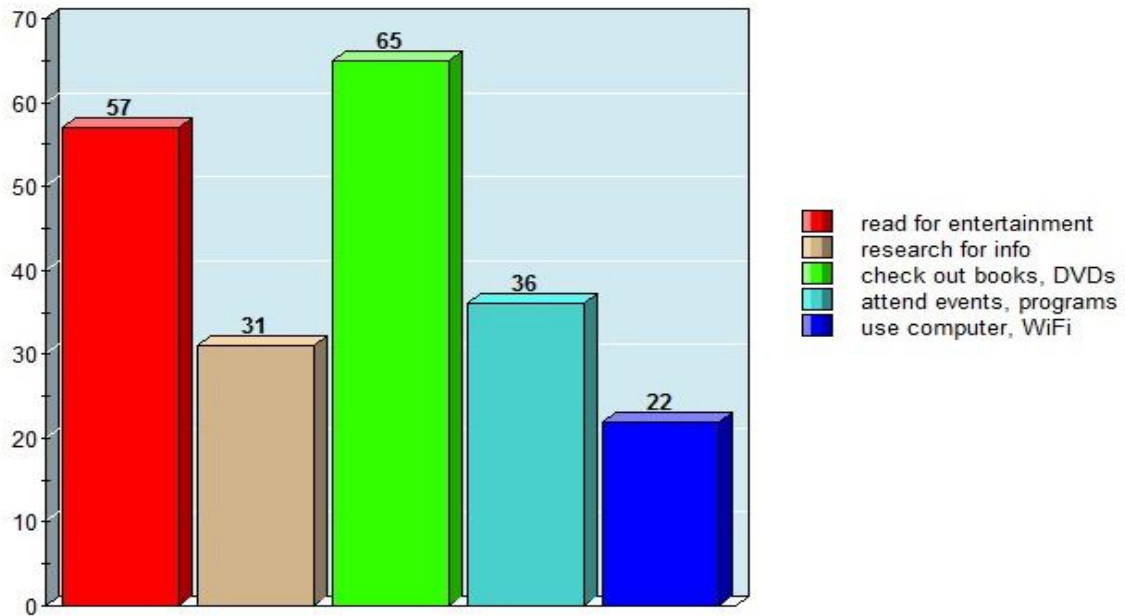
How does the library benefit you and the community?

- When I need Internet. Provides reading material and use the inter library service.

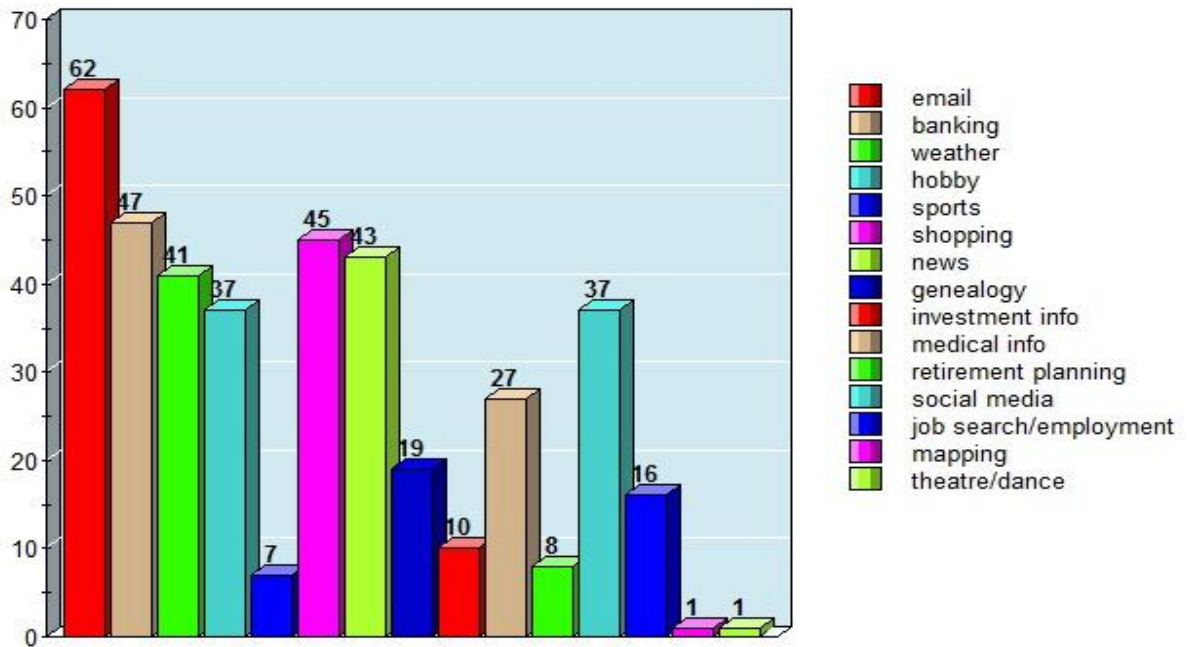
- It's a place to get new books, use a computer and many other things.

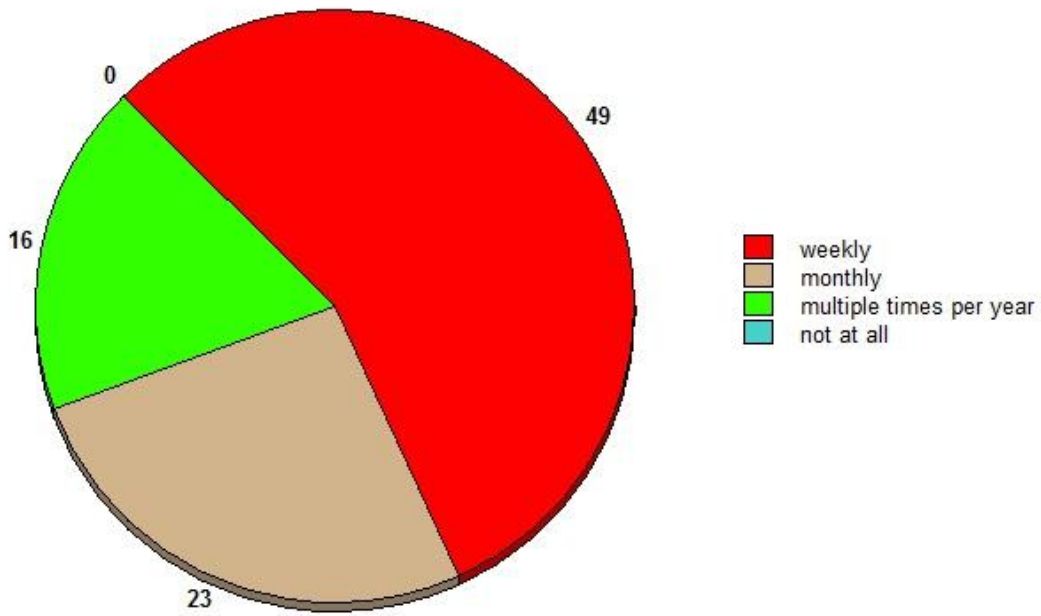
What do you use the library for?



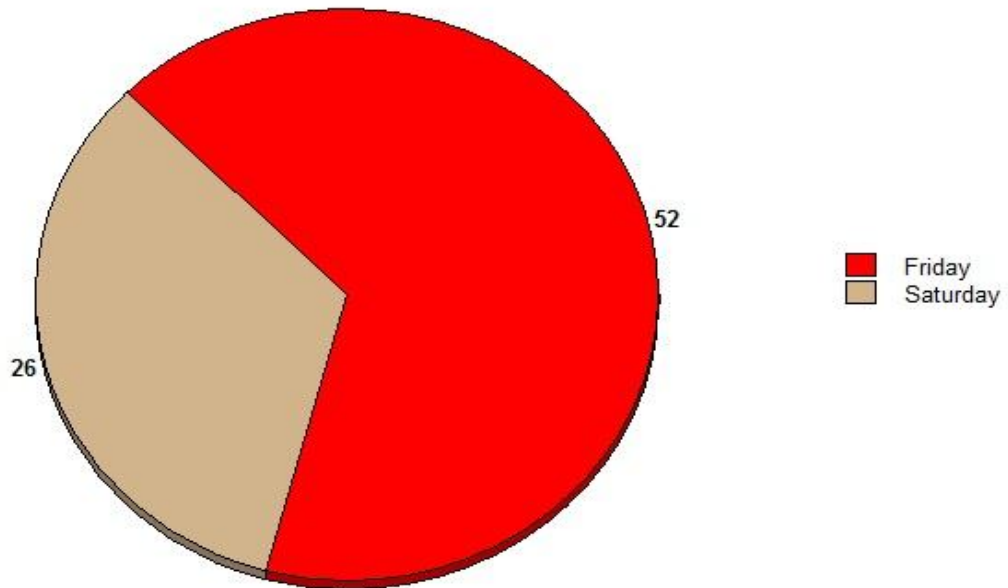
What do you do online?



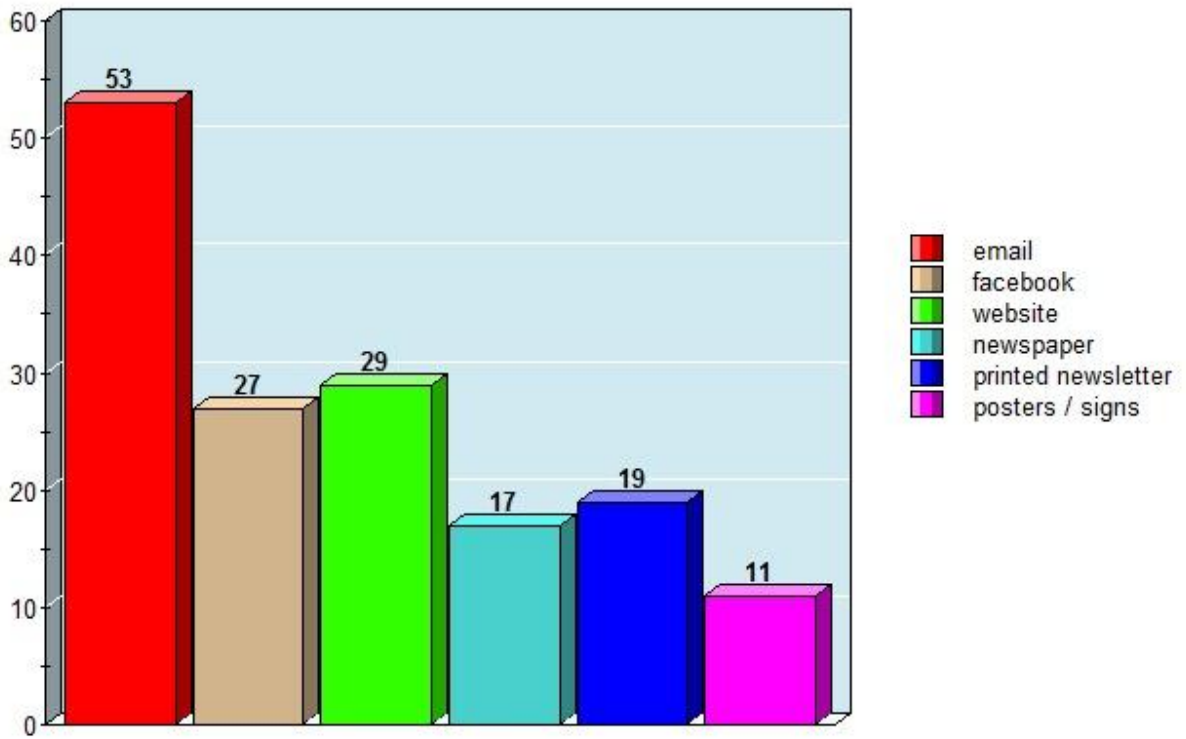
How often do you visit the library?



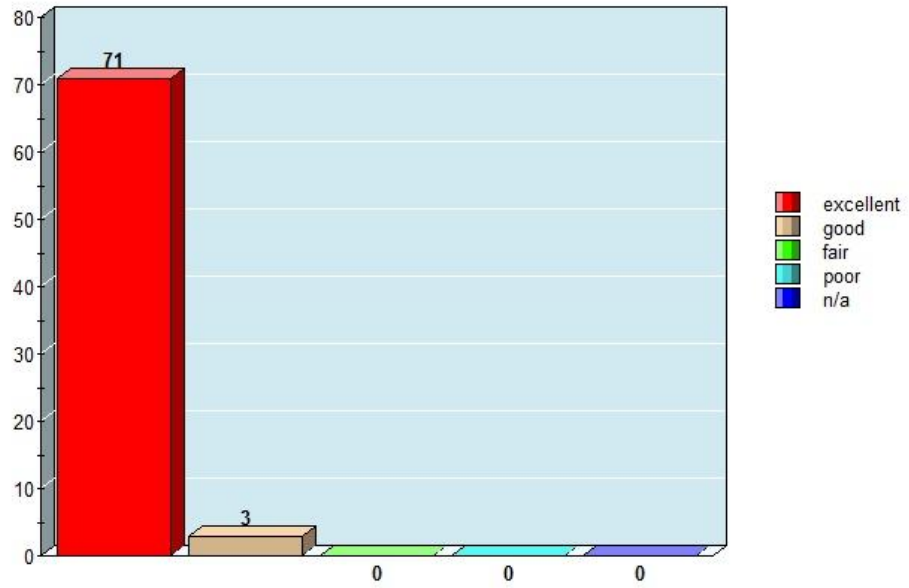

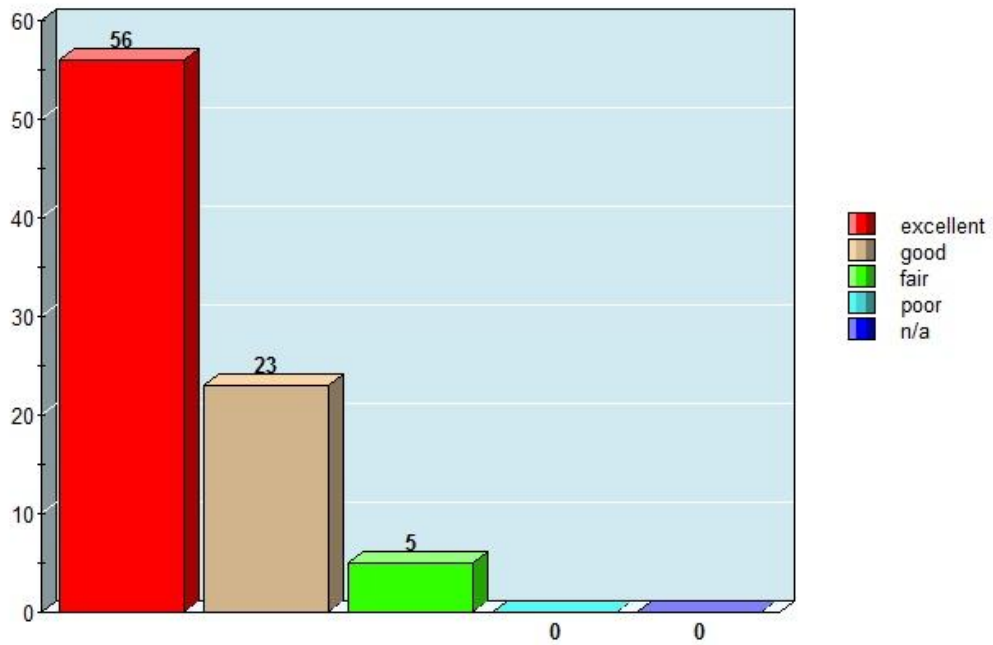

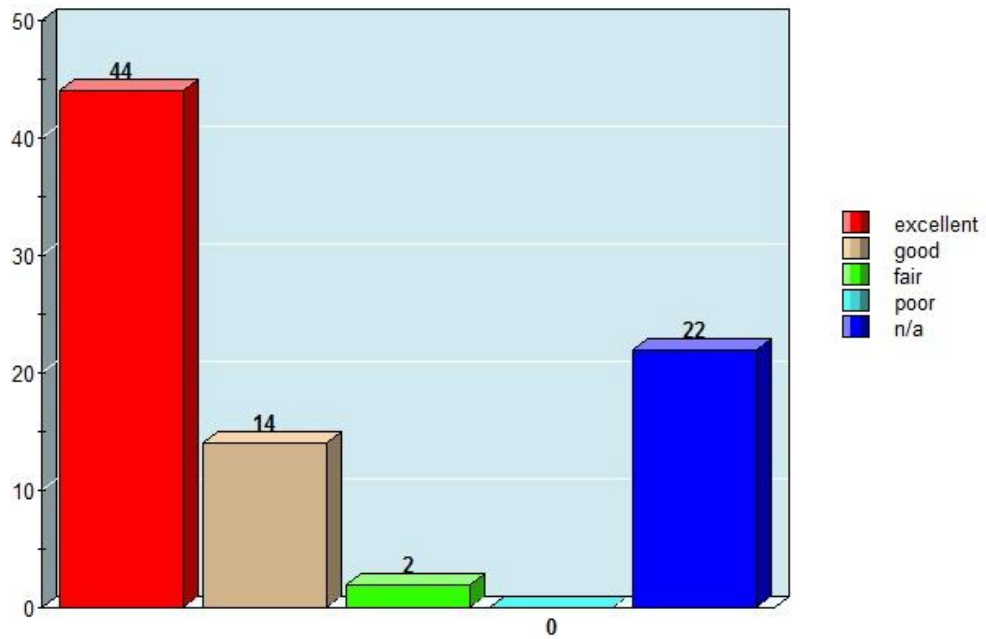
Rate - welcoming atmosphere



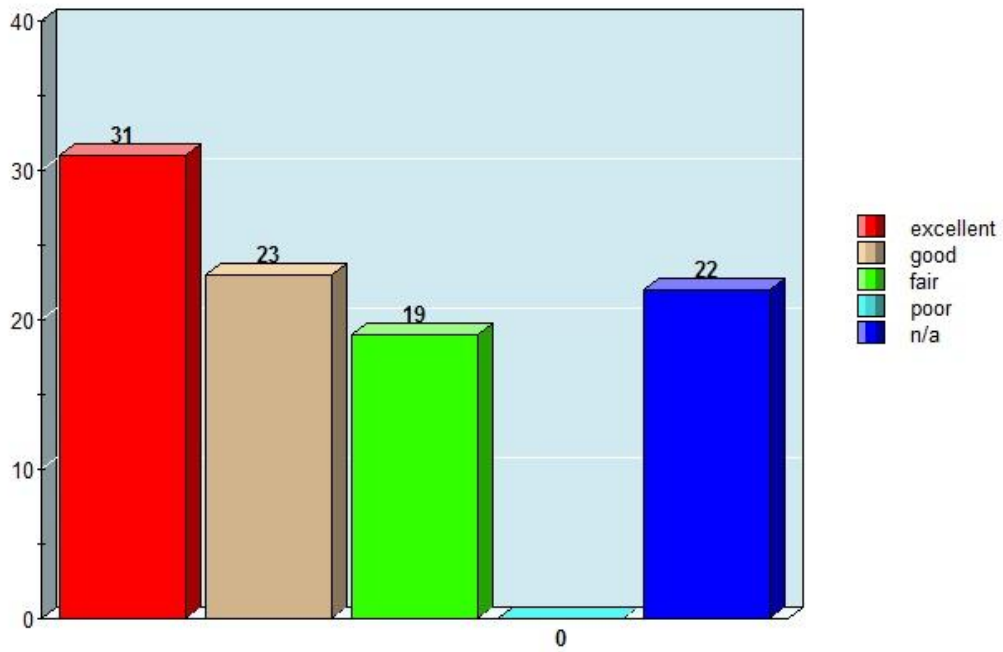
Rate - collections, books, DVDs, music, newspapers, etc.



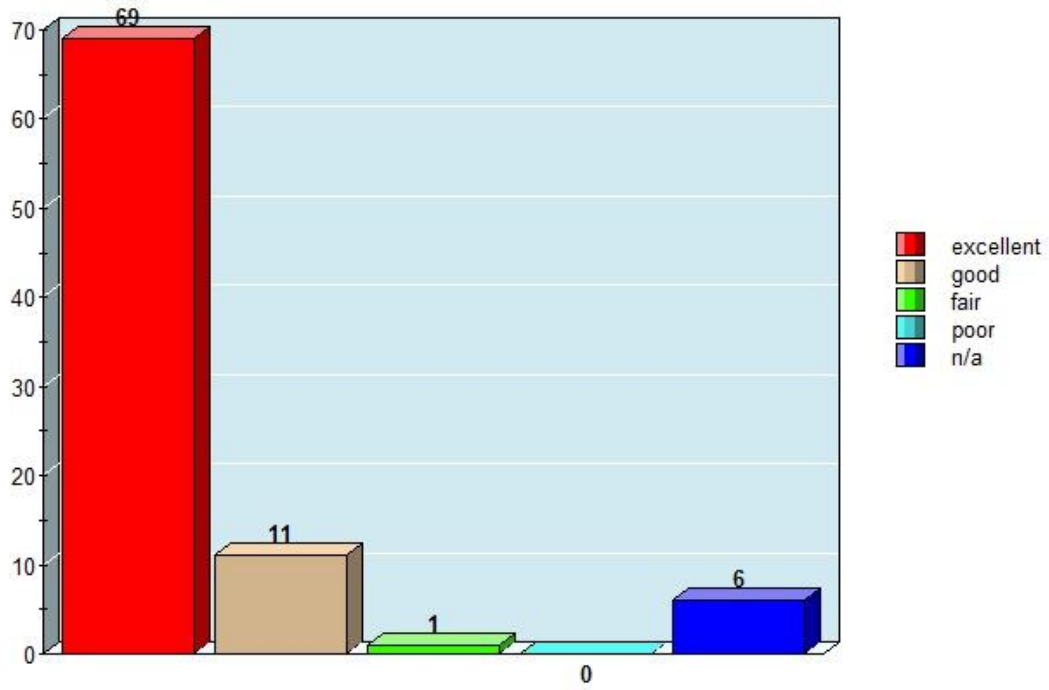
Rate - programs



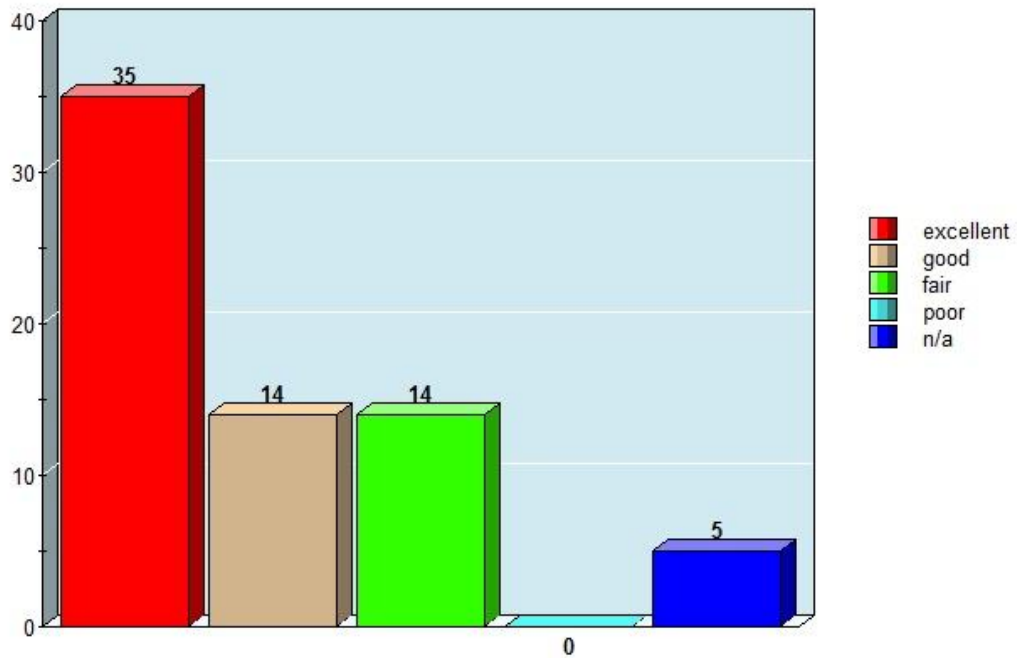
Rate - online services (website, catalog, research, etc.)



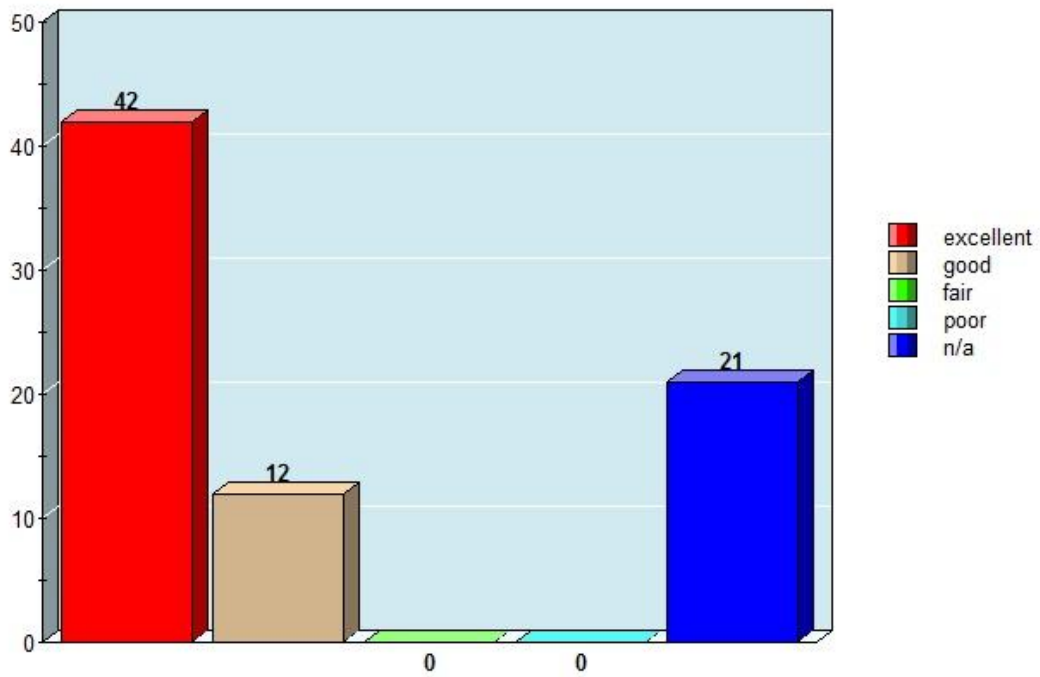
Rate - inter library loan / return



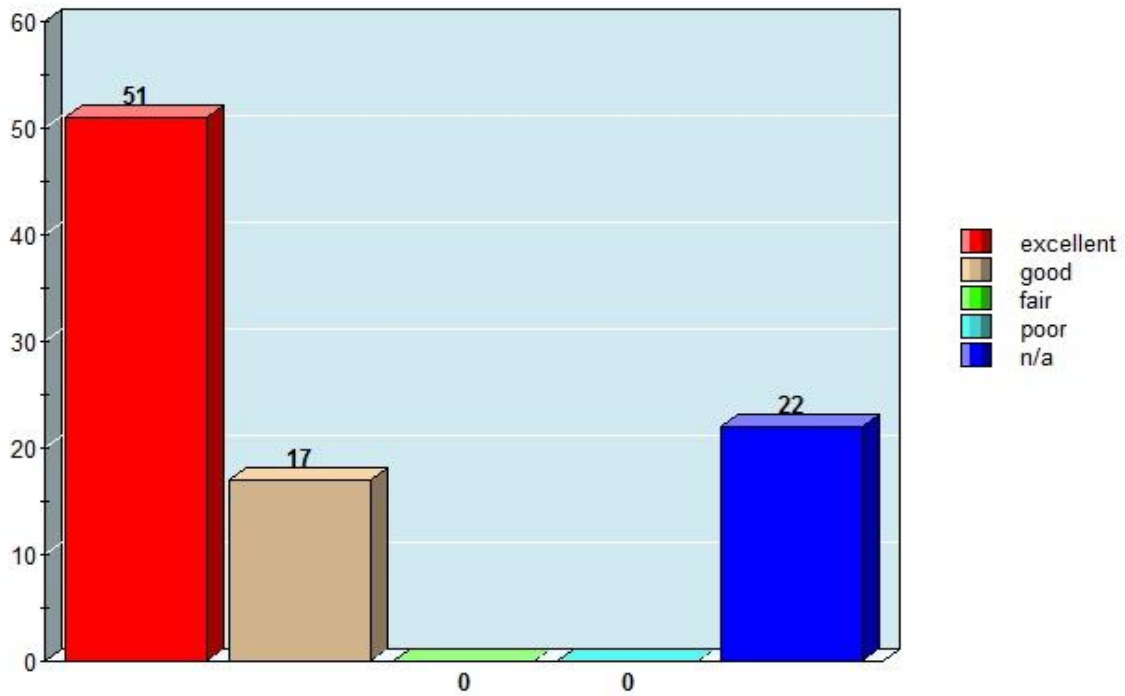
Rate - assistance w/ computers, technology



Rate - access to computers, technology

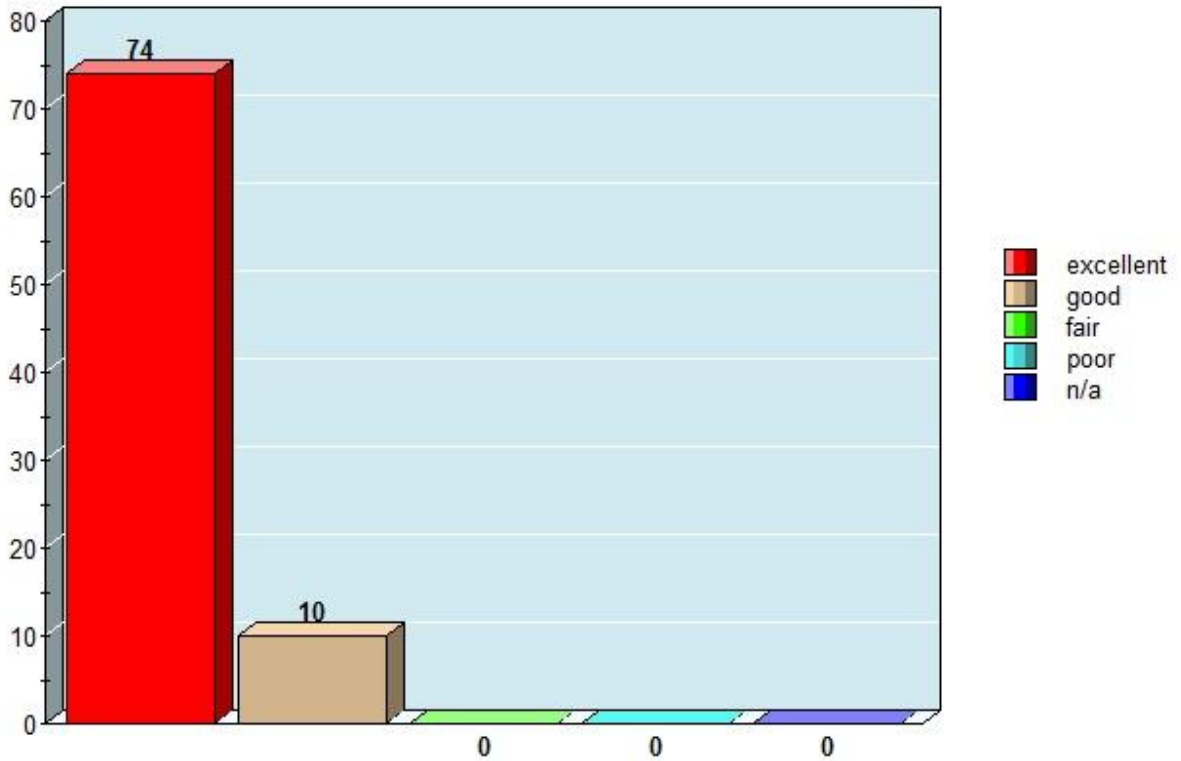


Rate - free Internet, WiFi
